Launched in 2019, the RD20 is a framework for international research and development aiming to strengthen international collaboration and promote innovation by leading research institutes in G20 countries and regions that develop the world's most advanced technologies for achieving carbon neutrality.

RD20 provides opportunities for participants to exchange R&D activities, experiences, and best practices related to clean energy technologies across countries and regions, as well as to explore the potential for international joint research. It also serves to deepen and develop new partnerships among relevant industry, academia, and government stakeholders.

The 5th RD20 conference will be held in Fukushima, the site of Japan's renewable energy frontier. Several international actions, including task forces on PV and hydrogen, summer school in France, and the Gigaton Hydrogen Workshop have been already launched. Leaders and experts of the institutes from G20 members will gather to accelerate collaboration and release the outcome all over the world.
