He is the founding Director of the [Science, Society and Sustainability \(3S\) Research Group](#) at UEA and is a Co-Director of the UK Energy Research Centre ([UKERC](#)) where he leads the Centre's [Public Engagement Observatory](#). Jason is a science and technology studies (STS) scholar and geographer concerned with the changing relations between science, democracy and society, particularly in relation to energy, climate change, sustainability and emerging technologies. A key focus of his work in these contexts has been on remaking how public participation and engagement is theorised, studied, and practiced, including new systemic and mapping participation approaches. His co-authored book [Remaking Participation: Science, Environment and Emergent Publics](#) (Routledge, 2016) received the European Association for the Study of Science and Technology (EASST) [Amsterdamska Award](#) in 2018.
